Move-in- Noon to 8:00PM Friday at Green gate exit from Fairview Drive (at rear of fairgrounds) follow signs or the Gold Gate entrance, at the North end of the fairgrounds, will be open between 2:00pm and 5:00pm, Friday only. This information is for Pavilion Display vehicles and their support vehicles only. If you are driving or trailering, you may avoid congestion at the Green Gate entrance by using the Gold Gate. There is drive-in access to the building. When you are driving on the carpet, please do not turn your steering wheel when you are stationary, it tends to damage the carpet. All entrants and vehicles will be required to present or display the passes enclosed at the entry gate. Please hang the orange "vehicle" ID tag on your rear view mirror or lay it face up on the dashboard. Short term (loading/unloading) parking is available within the grounds. However, most areas around the Pavilion are designated booth spaces and it makes our lives easier if you do not park in someone's booth before they have arrived to claim it. Trailer drop parking is available at the rear of the grounds. There is no designated exhibitor parking within the grounds.

Displaying your vehicle-We will provide stanchions and barriers around all Invitational Vehicles. If you have your own display, you may use it subject to show staff approval. We will also provide uniform signage for each vehicle. If you have a professionally prepared show card for your vehicle, you may use it. Fire Marshall requirements include disconnecting the battery, taping gas caps and ¼ tank or less of fuel. We can provide assistance if needed. We do not anticipate being required to pump fuel from tanks.

Commercial advertising-This display is not intended for commercial promotion of businesses or services other than what may be on your show card. Please limit any business card or advertisement. If you have questions, please contact the show staff.

For Sale signs- Please do not display for sale signs in your vehicle.

Judging, awards, trophies- This is real simple, there are none. This is an invitational display to share your cool vehicle with a bunch of car enthusiasts who will appreciate your pride and joy. We hope you enjoy the experience and consider this an opportunity to be part of a fun Northwest automotive happening.
